

Step 8 - Pull it straight and don't be late

I want this to be the final tab so I'll just recap for myself and for others what I expect to be 'doing' after I leave this document and finalise the rest of this thing via Cursor.

I expect to load a step 8 PDF into Gemini, plus all the step 0 to step 7 documents. I expect to generate a final bit of meta research that I want to use to then generate the 'hook' for the most lightly engaged audiences. Those who are experiencing total freedom from my attempt to decohere them from the normal state of coherent indifference. They are entirely non-locally observant of this thing I'm doing here, via steps 0 to 7, but that doesn't mean I can't still have a crack at a 'step 8' wrap up analysis. An analysis that can perhaps inform me of a way to more broadly break into the perceptual network of folks that are not sponsors, not judges and maybe not even remotely paying any attention to this GovHack 2025 event.

I need to deliver a video, so perhaps I can tie straight to some other knotted lines. Perhaps I can reference the Constructor S-57 project to loop in the Global Data Barometer folk. Perhaps I can reference the CKAN Community to loop in the Data Justice talk I delivered on 16 July via CKAN Monthly Live. Perhaps I can loop in the Canadian Open Data Society folk and reference the video I'm making for an audience at an event for 20 September 2025. There is chaos and control, and the insight I shared with the Open Government Partnership community earlier this year.

There is, for certain, the conversation I had on Thursday 28 August 2025 with the creative director of The Street, Caroline Stacey. I discussed with her the moment of clarity that comes from the right choice of words, but that there is then the compelling need to direct these words with the performative impact that is required for them to actually construct the reality they so deserve.

The prompt, for this final co-construction, must be as follows:

1. Generate a simple website that serves as a very easy on ramp for the most coherently indifferent audience I might be able to engage with on the matter of the GSC Model, the GovHack 'submissions' herein and the 'big ideas' that I have attempted to convey via this stepwise, unitarily unfolding and informationally rich pathway.
2. I also want you to generate the proposed slides for me to deliver a video overview as per the required GovHack submission requirements, which will be based on the timestamps you will find throughout these documents and the two challenges I am submitting this response for.
3. I would like a full summary of useful terminology used throughout all documents, so that I can provide

this as a reference for anyone who would like to a: understand the term more clearly or b: would like a link to where they can learn more or engage more with the topic.

4. Lastly, I have previously stated that within the Objective Observer Initiative that I am conducting an art-first approach to the exploration of topics now covered in these eight steps. I would like to conclude this submission with the performative reference to the meaningful and constructive impact of one's words. In a world of AI, trained and modelled from data to represent a pathway of prior attachments, there can emerge a shared and emergent substrate of meaning for us to use as our co-constructors. However, without change, such meaning is bunk. The words we bring forth and the meaning we construct must not be shared only within a model of semantic machine intelligence, it must be shared within a model of semantic social intelligence. To create meaningful and adaptive technologies is tied to the need to create meaningful and adaptive societies. I put forward, in the spirit of a rationalist debate, the GSC Model as the universal selector for such meaningful change.

The output you provide I will expect to use with Cursor to finalise my submission and to finalise my presentation, and all those bits and bobs as may be required :)
